The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following. Scheme:

## Commencement.and citation

1 (1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 17th September 1990 and may be cited as the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Amendiment (No 1) Scheme 1990.
(2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Inland Parcel Post Scheme 1989 (Post. Office Scheme P1/1989) (hereinafter called "the Scheme").

## Payment of postage and fees
