

RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM
THE NATIONAL LOANS FUND

NOTICE

THE Treasury in pursuance of Section 5 of the National Loans Act 1968 (as amended) hereby give notice that on or after 12th December 1990:—

- I. Different rates of interest shall apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);
- II. The lowest rates of interest satisfying the conditions laid down in Subsection (3) of the said Section 5 shall be:—

(INVERNESS CENTRAL CONSOLIDATION ORDER 1988)
RIVERSIDE STREET (NORTH) AND FACTORY STREET
(NORTH), INVERNESS — AMENDMENT ORDER 1990

NOTICE is hereby given that the Highland Regional Council have made an Order in terms of Section 1, 2 and 4 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 entitled as above.

HIGHLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, KYLE OF LOCHALSH)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 1990
