TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 1991

NOTICE is hereby given that Dumfries and Galloway Regional Council propose to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

1. The general effect of the Order will be to:—
 1. Imposes a maximum waiting limit of five minutes on public service vehicles using the Whitesands Rural Bus Stance.
 2. Create one taxi stance within the Whitesands Rural Bus Stance (taxis will not be subject to the five minute waiting restriction).
 3. Implement a Half Box Junction on Whitesands, Dumfries to facilitate access for public service vehicles and taxis to the Whitesands Rural Bus Stance.
2. Exceptions to the proposed restrictions are as stated in the Order.
3. Details of the proposals, with a plan (TM/D/03/28) showing the restricted lengths of road, draft Order, Order to be amended and Statement of Reasons for the proposed restriction may be inspected at the Council Offices, English Street, Dumfries during normal office hours between 21st December 1990 and 11th January 1991.
4. Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send details of the objection, in writing, to the undersigned by 11th January 1991.
