The procedure subsequent to the deposit of the Petition and Order will be by way of Provisional Order unless it be otherwise decided in terms of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1936, in which case the procedure may be by way of Private Bill and, in that case, this notice will, subject to the Standing Orders of Parliament, apply to such Bill.

TREASURY VALUE ADDED TAX

TREASURY DIRECTIONS dated 6 March 1991 under section 27(2A) of the Value Added Tax Act 1983 as to the refund to Government Departments of tax charged on the supply of goods and services or on the importation of goods received by them otherwise than for the purpose of carrying on activities in the course or furtherance of a business.

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 27(2A) of the Value Added Tax Act 1983 (1983 c.55), as inserted by section 11 of the Finance Act 1984 (1984 c.43), hereby direct as follows:

1. This direction shall come into operation on 1st April 1991.

2. In this direction:

“the direction” means the Treasury direction given under section 27(2A) of the Value Added Tax Act 1983 as inserted by Section 11 of the Finance Act 1984, dated 6th March 1989 as amended by the Treasury Direction given under that section dated 8th March 1990; and

“the Schedules” mean the Schedules to the direction.

3. Column (1) and column (2) of the Schedules specified in the left hand column of the table below shall be amended in accordance with the instructions contained in the middle and right hand columns of the table respectively.
