# THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS LETTER POST AMENDMENT (NO. 13) SCHEME 1991

Made	15th August 1991
Coming into operation	16th September 1991

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:—

### Commencement and citation

- (1) This Scheme shall come into operation on the 16 September 1991 and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 13) Scheme 1991.
  - (2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Scheme 1982 (Post Office Scheme P2/1982) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1982 (Post Office Scheme P6/1982), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1983 (Post Office Scheme P4/1983), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1984 (Post Office Scheme 3/1984), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1985 (Post Office Scheme 4/1985), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1986 (Post Office Scheme 2/1986), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 6) Scheme 1986 (Post Office Scheme 5/1986), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 7) Scheme 1987 (Post Office Scheme 2/1987), the Post Office

Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 8) Scheme 1988 (Post Office Scheme 3/1988), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 9) Scheme 1989 (Post Office Scheme L2/1989), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 10) Scheme 1990 (Post Office Scheme L1/1990), the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 11) Scheme 1991 (Post Office Scheme L1/1991), and the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 12) Scheme 1991 (Post Office Scheme L2/1991).

#### Letters and postcards other than airmail packets

- 2. Sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 5 of the Scheme as substituted by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 10) Scheme 1990 shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:
  - "(2)(i) Postage at the rates specified in part 2A of Schedule 1 shall be charged and paid on all European Airmail Letters and Postcards for transmission to European Economic Community destinations.
    - (ii) Postage at the rates specified in part 2B of Schedule 1 shall be charged and paid on all European Airmail Letters and Postcards for transmission to European destinations other than those of the European Economic Community".

#### Air Mail Packets

- Paragraph 9 of the Scheme as substituted by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 12) Scheme 1991, shall be amended as follows:
  - (a) in sub paragraph (a), the amount "32p" shall be deleted and "34p" inserted in its place;
  - (b) in sub-paragraph (b), the amount "17p" shall be deleted and "18p" inserted in its place.

## Small packets

- Sub-paragraph (4) of paragraph 24 of the Scheme as substituted by the Post Office Overseas Letter Post Amendment (No. 12) Scheme 1991 shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:
  - '(4) Subject to sub-paragraphs (5) and (6), small packets may be sealed'.

## Accelerated Treatment and express delivery

5. In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 29 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "£1.85" shall be deleted and "£1.95" inserted in its place.

# Registration

 In sub-paragraph (2)(c) of paragraph 32 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "£1.75" shall be deleted and "£1.90" inserted in its place.

## Compensation for registered packets

 In sub-paragraph (2)(b) of paragraph 33 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "£14" shall be deleted and "£24" inserted in its place.

# Compensation for certain other postal packets

 In sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 37 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "£22" shall be deleted and "£24" inserted in its place.

# Infectious perishable biological substances service

 In sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 50 of the Scheme as subsequently amended, the amount "£4.00" shall be deleted and "£4.25" inserted in its place.
