(WAITING RESTRICTIONS, HALF BOX JUNCTION AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC) AND (VARIOUS CAR PARKS) (USE RESTRICTIONS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 1985 AMENDMENT ORDER NO 1 1991

NOTICE is hereby given that Dumfries and Galloway Regional Council have made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

1. The general effect of the Order will be to:—

1. Impose a maximum waiting limit of ten minutes, with no return within ten minutes on public service vehicles using the Whitesands Rural Bus Stance.
2. Create one taxi stance within the Whitesands Rural Bus Stance (taxis will not be subject to the ten minute waiting restrictions).
3. Implement a half box junction on Whitesands, Dumfries to facilitate access for public service vehicles and taxis to the Whitesands Rural Bus Stance.
4. Impose a One Way Traffic working at the entrance to Whitesands Rural Bus Stance.

2. The Order and relevant plan (TM/D/03/28A) may be inspected at the Council Offices, English Street, Dumfries during normal office hours.

3. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 17th September 1991 apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
