

3. Exceptions include waiting for the following purposes:—

- (a) boarding or alighting from vehicles
- (b) building or demolition operations
- (c) road maintenance, improvement or reconstruction
- (d) statutory powers and duties
- (e) the supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications apparatus
- (f) bus travel and
- (g) by disabled drivers

4. Full details of the proposals are contained in the Order which, together with a plan showing the length of road which will be affected and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for wishing to make the Order, may be examined without payment of fee at Fife Regional Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes and at Fife Regional Council Area Office, 82 High Street, Dunfermline.

5. Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send details of the grounds for objection in writing to the undersigned by 11th October 1991.
