- (a) On the north side thereof from its junction with Station Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 29 metres or thereby.
- (b) On the north side thereof from its junction with Station Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 9 metres or thereby.

Greenacre Place

- (a) On the west side thereof from its junction with Quakerfield in a southerly direction for a distance of 16 metres or thereby.
- (b) On the east side thereof from its junction with Quakerfield in a southerly direction for a distance of 14 metres or thereby.

Newmarket

- (a) On the north side thereof from a point opposite the west boundary of No. 35 Newmarket, in an easterly direction to the west boundary of Stein Square, a distance of 82 metres or thereby.
