GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

THE Secretary of State for Scotland, by this licence issued under the terms of Article 4 of the Importation of Animal Products and Poultry Products Order 1980 (as amended) authorises subject to and in accordance with the conditions set out below the landing in Scotland of:-

Poultrymeat preparations derived from chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese and guinea fowls from Belgium, Denmark, France, Greece, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Spain, Portugal, Republic of Ireland at all ports and airports in Scotland until further notice unless revoked by the Secretary of State
