INDEX-LINKED NATIONAL SAVINGS

MOVEMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM GENERAL OF
RETAIL PRICES

FOR the purposes of revaluing on repayment Index-linked National Savings Certificates (Retirement Issue, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Index-Linked Issues) and contributions under Save As You Earn savings contracts (Third Issue) and for revising the annual rate of interest for Indexed-Income Bonds, the Index figure issued by the Central Statistical Office in the month of October and applicable to the month of November is 139.4. This figure is based on the revised reference base of 100 adopted in January 1987. In accordance with the relevant prospectuses a notional Index figure of 549.9 has been calculated and will apply to Index-linked Savings Certificates and Indexed-Income Bonds purchased in March 1987 or earlier and SAYE contributions which were due for payment and made in February 1987 or earlier.

INSURANCE COMPANIES ACT 1982

NORDEN INSURANCE COMPANY (UK) LIMITED

TRANSFER OF GENERAL BUSINESS

1. NOTICE is hereby given that Norden Insurance Company (UK) Limited applied to the Secretary of State for Trade & Industry on 6th May 1992 for his approval, pursuant to section 51 of the Insurance Companies Act 1982, to transfer to UNI Storebrand Insurance Company (UK) Limited all of its rights and obligations under the general insurance business portfolio written by it in the United Kingdom prior to 6th May 1992.
2. Copies of the Statement of Particulars of the proposed transfer are available for inspection at the offices of Norden Insurance Company (UK) Limited at Plantation House, 5-8 Mincing Lane, London EC3M 3DX from Monday to Friday between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm on any usual business day until 15th November 1992.
3. Written representations concerning the transfer may be sent to the Secretary of State for Trade & Industry, Dept of Trade and Industry, Insurance Division, 10-18 Victoria Street, London SW1H 0NN before 15th December 1992. The Secretary of State will not determine the application until after considering any representations made to him before that date.

WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1967

Authority given under section 7

WHEREAS:

- a) selling or offering for sale, letting on hire or offering to let on hire, or indicating (whether by display of the apparatus or by any form of advertisement) one's willingness to sell or let on hire, having the custody or control and the importation of certain wireless telegraphy apparatus are restricted by the Wireless Telegraphy (Cordless Telephone Apparatus) (Restriction and Marking) Order 1992 (SI. 1992/2009) ("the Order"); and
- (b) the Secretary of State is satisfied that this Authority and the terms and conditions attached to it are compatible with the international obligations of the United Kingdom;

NOW, THEREFORE:

1. The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7 of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967 (c.72), gives authority to any person to:-
 - a) sell or offer for sale, let on hire or offer to let on hire, or indicate (whether by display of the apparatus or by any form of advertisement) his willingness to sell or let on hire;
 - b) have in custody or control; or
 - c) import
 restricted cordless telephone apparatus subject to the terms and conditions specified in paragraphs 2,3, 4 and 5.
2. The apparatus shall be sold or offered for sale, or let on hire or offered to let on hire, be in the person's custody or control or be imported for the sole purpose of re-export.
3. The apparatus, while in the United Kingdom, shall be held in a custom's warehouse on premises approved by the Commissioners of Customs and Excise.
4. The apparatus shall not be sold or offered for sale, or let on hire or offered to let on hire, for use in the United Kingdom.
