IMPORTATION OF BIRDS, POULTRY AND HATCHING EGGS ORDER 1979

IMPORT LICENCE

THE Secretary of State for Scotland, by this licence issued under Article 4 of The Importation of Birds, Poultry and Hatching Eggs Order 1979 hereby authorises, in accordance with the conditions set out below, the importation into Scotland:

Poultry and hatching eggs as defined in Directive 90/539 EEC other than domestic fowl (see notes 3 and 4) from Member States of the European Community at any port or airport in Scotland with HM Customs and Excise facilities.

This licence comes into force with effect from 31st October 1992.

The Secretary of State may by Notice vary, revoke or suspend this licence at any time.

Any expressions used in this licence have the same meaning which they bear in the Animal Health Act 1981.

CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS LICENCE

1. All landings must be in accordance with the provisions of the Importation of Birds, Poultry and Hatching Eggs Order 1979, and with the following provisions of this licence.

2. Each consignment must be accompanied at all times by a health certificate in accordance with Annex IV of Council Directive 90/539/EEC on animal health conditions governing intra-Community trade in and imports from third countries of, poultry and hatching eggs. The health certificate must be:

- 2.1 contained on a single sheet of paper and written in English and an official language of the country of export;
- 2.2 signed by an official veterinarian of the country of export on the day of loading;
- 2.3 stamped in a colour different from that of the certificate;
- 2.4 made out to a single consignee; and
- 2.5 valid for a period of 5 days.

3. Consignees must notify, in writing, the local Divisional Veterinary Officer of the Scottish Office Agriculture and Fisheries
