2. The effect of the Order which will come into operation on the 23rd day of November, 1992 will be to further amend the existing provisions of The Fife Regional Council (Various Streets, Glenrothes) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 1979 and will result in the prohibition of waiting of vehicles at any time in the various turning heads located in Rothesay Place, Glenrothes.
3. Full details of the proposals are contained in the Order which, together with a map showing the lengths of road which will be affected and a copy of the principal Order to be amended may be examined without payment of fee at Fife Regional Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes during normal office hours.
4. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from the 17th day of November, 1992, apply to the Court of Session for the purpose.

THE FIFE REGIONAL COUNCIL (RUMBLINGWELL, WILLIAM STREET, BALDRIDGEBURN AND EAST BALDRIDGE DRIVE, DUNFERMLINE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 1991

1. On the 17th day of November, 1992 The Fife Regional Council made an Order under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (2), 3(2) and 124 of and paragraph 20(1) of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The effect of the Order which comes into operation on the 7th day of December, 1992 will be to prohibit waiting and loading at any time at the junction of Rumblingwell, William Street, Baldridgeburn and East Baldridge Drive, Dunfermline.
3. Exceptions include waiting for the following purposes:-
 - (a) boarding or alighting from vehicles
 - (b) building or demolition operations
 - (c) road maintenance, improvement or reconstruction
 - (d) statutory powers and duties
 - (e) the supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications apparatus
 - (f) bus travel and
 - (g) by disabled drivers
4. Full details of the proposals are contained in the Order which, together with a plan showing the lengths of road which will be affected may be examined without payment of fee at Fife

Regional Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes and at Fife Regional Council Area Office, 82 High Street, Dunfermline.

5. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from the 17th day of November, 1992, apply to the Court of Session for the purpose.
