(17 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1992

THE STRATHCLYDE REGIONAL COUNCIL (B7083 CUMNOCK/AUCHINLECK)

(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1992

ON Friday, 20th November 1992, the Regional Council made the above-named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1974.

The Order, which comes into operation on Monday, 30th November, 1992, imposes a 40 mph speed limit on that length of the B7083 from a point 18 metres or thereby northwest of the junction with Holmhead Road, Cumnock, in a north westerly direction for a distance of 1122 metres or thereby.
