PIPE-LINE WORKS AUTHORISATION

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRADE AND INDUSTRY hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by Conoco (U.K.) Limited, whose address is Park House, 116 Park Street, London W1Y 4NN for the construction of a 16 inch and a 3 inch pipe-line between the Caister Platform and the Murdoch Platform.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the 16 inch pipe-line shall only be used to convey gas and the 3 inch pipe-line shall only be used to convey methanol. The pipe-lines may be used by the holder and with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.
