ANIMAL HEALTH ACT 1981

THE IMPORTATION OF ANIMALS ORDER 1977

(ARTICLE 3(2))

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR SCOTLAND, by this licence issued under Article 3 (2) of the Importation of Animals Order 1977, hereby authorises the landing in Great Britain, in accordance with the conditions set out below, of Sheep originating in Northern Ireland at Cairnryan, Stranraer

Scotland General Licence No 41 dated 16th September 1985 is hereby revoked. This licence is valid until varied or revoked by the Secretary of State.

CONDITIONS

1. All landings of sheep shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Importation of Animal Order 1977 and with the following provisions of this licence.
2. Shipment must be direct from Northern Ireland to Great Britain.
3. The sheep shall be accompanied by the following document:

A certificate signed by a veterinary inspector appointed by the

Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland stating that:

- 3.1 The sheep were examined by him immediately before consignment to Great Britain and
 - 3.1.1 showed no evidence of infectious or contagious disease and were fit to travel;
 - 3.1.2 after examination they have been kept separate from sheep not so certified.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

1. Importers, must ensure that the Animal Health Office responsible for the place of destination is notified of the proposed import at least 24 hours before the expected time of arrival.
2. Arrival at the destination, shall be notified to the Animal Health Office responsible.
3. The health certification must accompany the consignment to its final destination and be retained there for a minimum period of 12 months for presentation on request.

NOTE

In the event of the consignment being delayed or postponed importers should advise the Animal Health Office responsible for the place of destination.
