**THE TRUNK ROADS (KIRKCONNEL)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING)
(VARIATION) ORDER 199**

make the above Order to change the waiting and loading restrictions in Main Street, Kirkconnel.

The Trunk Roads (Kirkconnel) (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading) Order 1974-SI no. 1616 will be varied as follows:-

1. In Article 6, subparagraph (a) for the words "30 minutes" there shall be substituted the words "60 minutes".
2. In Article 6, subparagraph (b) for the words "30 minutes" there shall be substituted the words "60 minutes".
3. In Schedule 1 paragraph 2 there shall be inserted after subparagraph (b) the following: -

"from a point opposite the east end of No 92 Main Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 15 yards (14 metres) or thereby".

4. Schedule 4 paragraph 1 shall be deleted.

5. Schedule 4 paragraph 2 shall be amended to read as follows:-

"on the south side of the road from a point 25 yards (23 metres) or thereby west of the junction with Needle Street in a westerly direction, for a distance of 106 yards (97 metres) or thereby".
