COMPANY DIRECTORS DISQUALIFICATION ACT 1986

IN a summary application presented to Inverness Sheriff Court of terms of 6(1) of the above Act at the incidence of Her Majesty's Secretary of State for Trade and Industry against William George MacLennan, 38 Edington Road, Inverness the Court has on 12th October 1993 pronounced *inter alia* the following:-

"The Sheriff on the motion of the Applicant grants a disqualification order under section 6(1) of the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 against William George MacLennan residing at 38 Edington Road, Inverness ordering that he shall not, without leave of the Court, be a director of a company or, in any way, either directly or indirectly, be concerned or take part in the promotion, formation or management of a company for a period of 15 years from this date".
