A PROCLAMATION

DETERMINING THE SPECIFICATIONS AND DESIGN FOR TWO-POUND COINS COMMEMORATING THE
TERCENTENARY OF THE BANK OF ENGLAND AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

ELIZABETH R.

WHEREAS under section 3(1)(a), (b), (cc), (d) and (dd) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to determine the denomination, design, dimensions, weight and composition of coins to be made at Our Mint and to determine the remedy to be allowed in the making of such coins and the percentage of impurities which they may contain:

And Whereas under section 3(1)(f) and (ff) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to direct that coins other than of gold, silver, cupro-nickel and bronze shall be current and that any coin shall be legal tender for payment of any amount:

And Whereas under section 6(2) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, by Proclamation, to prescribe the composition of the standard trial plates to be used for determining the justness of coins issued from Our Mint of any metal or mixture of metals other than gold, silver and cupro-nickel:

And Whereas it appears to Us desirable, in order to commemorate the tercentenary of the Bank of England in the year One thousand nine hundred and ninety-four, that there should be made at Our Mint in gold, in silver and in nickel-brass coins of the denomination of two pounds:

We, therefore, in pursuance of the said section 3(1)(a), (b), (cc), (d), (dd), (f) and (ff) and the said section 6(2) and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf do hereby, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, proclaim, direct and ordain as follows:-

GOLD COIN

1. A new coin of gold of the denomination of two pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard diameter of 28.4 millimetres, and being circular in shape.

SILVER COINS

2. (1) A new coin of silver of the denomination of two pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 31.952 grammes, a standard diameter of 28.4 millimetres, and a standard composition of thirty-seven-fortieths fine silver and three-fortieths alloy, or millesimal fineness 925, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said silver coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, diameter or composition specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not

exceeding the following, that is to say:-

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin (measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogramme of the coin) of 0.145 grammes;

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.1 millimetres per coin; and

(c) a variation from the said millesimal fineness of five per mille.

(3) The said silver coin shall be legal tender for payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

3. (1) A new coin of silver of the denomination of two pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 15.976 grammes, a standard diameter of 28.4 millimetres, and a standard composition of thirty-seven-fortieths fine silver and three-fortieths alloy, or millesimal fineness 925, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said silver coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, diameter or composition specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:-

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin (measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogramme of the coin) of 0.095 grammes;

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.1 millimetres per coin; and

(c) a variation from the said millesimal fineness of five per mille.

(3) The said silver coin shall be legal tender for payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

NICKEL-BRASS COIN

4. (1) A new coin of nickel-brass of the denomination of two pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 15.976 grammes, a standard diameter of 28.4 millimetres, and a standard composition of seventy per centum copper, five and one-half per centum nickel and twenty-four and one-half per centum zinc, and being circular in shape.

(2) In the making of the said nickel-brass coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, diameter or composition specified above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:

(a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin (measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogramme of the coin) of - 0.095 grammes:

(b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.1 millimetres per coin; and

(c) a variation from the said standard composition of two per centum copper, three-quarters per centum nickel and two per centum zinc.

(3) The coin may contain impurities of 0.75 of one per centum.

(4) The said nickel-brass coin shall be current and be legal tender for payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

5. The composition of the standard trial plates to be used for determining the justness of the said nickel-brass coin shall be pure copper, pure nickel and pure zinc.

DESIGN FOR THE COINS

6. The design for the said gold, silver and nickel-brass coins shall be as follows:-

For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "ELIZABETH.II.DEI.GRATIA.REGINA.F.D" and the words "TWO POUNDS", and for the reverse a central medallion bearing a representation of the Seal of the Bank of England showing a female figure habited in classical attire representing Britannia looking upon a bank of money holding aloft in the left hand a sprig of olive and with the right hand supporting a spear and resting upon a Cartouche bearing the Cross of St George all within a laurel wreath and exterior to which the dates "1694" to the left and "1994" to the right, in chief a cypher comprising the interlaced letters "W" and "M" ensigned by a representation of the Royal Crown all accompanied by four roundels each bearing a shield debriused overall by a Cross couped arranged 2 and 2, and in base the words "Bank of England". The gold coin shall have a graining upon the edge; and the silver and nickel brass coin shall have a graining upon the edge and in incuse letters the inscription "SIC VOS NON VOBIS".

7. This Proclamation shall come into force on the twenty-eighth day of October One thousand nine hundred and ninety-three.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this twenty-seventh day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and ninety-three and in the forty-second year of Our Reign.

ALTERING THE PROCLAMATION OF 11TH FEBRUARY 1983 AND THE PROCLAMATION OF 20TH APRIL 1983 AND
DETERMINING THE DESIGN FOR ONE POUND COINS

ELIZABETH R.

WHEREAS under section 3(1)(b) and (h) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to determine the design of any coin to be made at Our Mint and to revoke or alter any Proclamation previously made under the said section:

And Whereas by Our Proclamation dated the eleventh day of February 1983 We ordered that new coins of silver of the denomination of one pound should be made at Our Mint and by Our Proclamations dated the seventeenth day of April 1985 and the twenty-sixth day of October 1988, We altered section 2 of of Our said Proclamation of the eleventh day of February 1983 to determine new designs for the said one pound coins:

And Whereas by Our Proclamation dated the twentieth day of April 1983 We ordered that a new coin of nickel-brass of the denomination of one pound should be made at Our Mint and by Our Proclamations dated the twenty-second day of June 1983 and the twenty-third day of March 1988, We altered section 2 of of Our said Proclamation of the twentieth day of April 1983 to determine new designs for the said one pound coin:

And Whereas it appears to Us desirable to determine a new design for the said one pound coins of silver and the said one pound coin of nickel-brass:

We, therefore, in pursuance of the said section 3(1)(b) and (h) and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf do hereby, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, proclaim, direct and ordain as follows:-

SILVER COINS

1. The following section shall be substituted for section 2 of Our said Proclamation of the eleventh day of February 1983:-

"2. The design for the said coins shall be as follows:-

For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "ELIZABETH II D.G.REG.F.D." and the date of the year, and for the reverse either -

(a) three Lions passant guardant, being that quartering of Our Royal Arms known heraldically as England,

(b) a Lion rampant within a double Tressure flory counter-flory, being that quartering of Our Royal Arms known heraldically as Scotland,

(c) a Dragon passant, being Our badge for Wales,

(d) a Celtic Cross charged at the centre with an Annulet therein a Pimpemel flower and overall an ancient Torque, in allusion to that part of Our United Kingdom known as Northern Ireland,

(e) a Shield of Our Royal Arms ensigned by a representation of Our Royal Crown,

(f) the Ensigns Armorial of Our United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland,

(g) an Oak Tree enfiling a representation of Our Royal Diadem,

(h) a Thistle eradicated enfiling a representation of Our Royal Diadem,

(i) a Leek eradicated enfiling a representation of Our Royal Diadem, or

(j) a Flax Plant eradicated enfiling a representation of Our Royal Diadem

and beneath the same the words "ONE POUND". The coins shall have a graining upon the edge and in incuse letters the inscription "DECUS ET TUTAMEN" or, in the case of coins bearing the impression of a tressured Lion rampant or a Thistle, "NEMO ME IMPUNE LACESSIT" or, in the case of coins bearing the impression of a Dragon passant or a Leek, "PLEIDIOL WYF I'M GWLAD".

NICKEL-BRASS COIN

2. The following section shall be substituted for section 2 of Our said Proclamation of the twentieth day of April 1983:-

"2. The design for the said coin shall be as follows:-

For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "ELIZABETH II D.G.REG.F.D." and the date of the year, and for the reverse either -

(a) three Lions passant guardant, being that quartering of Our Royal Arms known heraldically as England,

(b) a Lion rampant within a double Tressure flory counter-flory, being that quartering of Our Royal Arms known heraldically as Scotland,

(c) a Dragon passant, being Our badge for Wales,

(d) a Celtic Cross charged at the centre with an Annulet therein a Pimpernel flower and overall an ancient Torque, in allusion to that part of Our United Kingdom known as Northern Ireland,

(e) a Shield of Our Royal Arms ensigned by a representation of Our Royal Crown,

(f) the Ensigns Armorial of Our United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland,

(g) an Oak Tree enfiling a representation of Our Royal Diadem,

(h) a Thistle eradicated enfiling a representation of Our Royal Diadem,

(i) a Leek eradicated enfiling a representation of Our Royal Diadem, or

(j) a Flax Plant eradicated enfiling a representation of Our Royal Diadem

and beneath the same the words "ONE POUND". The coin shall have a graining upon the edge and in incuse letters the inscription "DECUS ET TUTAMEN" or, in the case of a coin bearing the impression of a tressured Lion rampant or a Thistle, "NEMO ME IMPUNE LACESSIT" or, in the case of a coin bearing the impression of a Dragon passant or a Leek, "PLEIDIOL WYF I'M GWLAD".

3. Our said Proclamations of the twenty-sixth day of October 1988 and of the twentythird day of March 1988 shall be revoked and this Proclamation shall come into force on the twenty-eighth day of October One thousand nine hundred and ninety-three. Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace. this twenty-seventh day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and ninety-three and in the forty-second year of Our Reign.

RIVER CLYDE AND DAER WATER

PROPOSED PROTECTION ORDER

1. NOTICE is hereby given that proposals have been submitted to the Secretary of State for a Protection Order to be made, under section 1 of the Freshwater and Salmon Fisheries (Scotland) Act 1976, for the main stem of the River Clyde upstream from Bothwell Bridge and the Daer Water downstream from the Daer Reservoir.
2. The general effect of the proposals is that, if implemented, they would result in a significant increase in availability of access to freshwater fishings in the waters described at charges of between £3 - £4 per rod per day, or between £12 - £18 per rod per season; and would prohibit persons without legal right or without written permission from a person having such a right, from fishing for freshwater fish in those waters.
