PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 1994

THE BORDERS REGIONAL COUNCIL propose to make this Order. It will be submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation, except that, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2(1)(a) of Schedule 3 to the Countryside (Scotland) Act 1967, as amended, if no representations or objections are duly made to The Borders Regional Council, or, if any so made are withdrawn, the Order shall on being made take effect without it having to be submitted to the Secretary of State and without his confirmation.

The effect of the Order as proposed will be to realign a short section of the right of way leading from Jenny Moore's Road, St Boswells to the St Boswells primary school access roadway to follow a line approximately 12 metres northwest of its present line.

A draft of the Order, a map showing the existing and proposed routes and a statement of reasons for making the Order can be seen at the Regional Headquarters, Newtown St Boswells free of charge during office hours.
