THE FIFE REGIONAL COUNCIL

(VARIOUS STREETS, CELLARDYKE)

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1994

1. ON the 1st day of November, 1994, The Fife Regional Council made an Order under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1)

and (2) and 124 of and paragraph 20(1) of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The effect of the Order which will come into effect on the 14th day of November 1994 will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on certain lengths of various streets in Cellardyke.
3. Exceptions include waiting for the following purposes:-
 - (a) boarding or alighting from vehicles
 - (b) the loading or unloading of goods
 - (c) building or demolition operations
 - (d) road maintenance, improvement or reconstruction
 - (e) statutory powers and duties
 - (f) the supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications apparatus
 - (g) bus travel and
 - (h) by disabled drivers.
4. Full details of the proposals are contained in the Order which, together with a plan showing the lengths of road which will be affected, may be examined without payment of fee at Fife Regional Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes and at Anstruther Post Office, 36 Shore Street, Anstruther.
5. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from the 1st day of November 1994, apply to the Court of Session for the purpose.

THE FIFE REGIONAL COUNCIL

(ROSE STREET, BURNTISLAND) (ONE-WAY) ORDER 1994

1. ON the 1st day of November 1994 The Fife Regional Council made an Order under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (2) and 124 of and paragraphs 20(1) of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The effect of the Order which will come into operation on the 14th day of November 1994 will be that no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto otherwise than in the permitted direction of travel specified opposite to the said length of road in the said Schedule.
3. A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the length of road affected, may be examined during normal office hours at Fife Regional Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes and at Burntisland Post Office, 192-196 High Street, Burntisland without payment of fee.
