PROPOSED STOPPING UP AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Strathclyde Regional Council propose to consider the introduction of the following orders:-

- (1) An order under Section 68 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 stopping up the roads and footpath described in the Schedule hereto. The title of this order is The Strathclyde Regional Council (Station Road, Hamilton) (Stopping Up) Order 199
- (2) An order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which will introduce traffic management measures in a new road to be constructed, which will realign Station Road, Hamilton, in a new car park Access road which will form a junction with the realigned Station Road, and in Orchard Street, Hamilton. The proposed measures to include:- the introduction of waiting and loading restrictions generally on the aforementioned roads; the introduction of one way operation westwards in the new Access Road to the car park; and the amendment and revocation of existing orders, as required. The title of this Order is The Strathclyde Regional Council (Realigned Stations Road and Orchard Street) (Traffic Management) Order 199

Roads to be Stopped Up

Lengths of Road in the Region of Strathclyde

1. That length of Station Road, Hamilton, shown zebra hatched on the plan annexed, extending from the extended south kerbline of Brandon Street southwards then westwards for a distance of 282 metres or thereby to a line 11 metres or thereby east of the extended southeast kerbline of Orchard Street.
2. That length of road, shown zebra hatched on the plan annexed, extending from a line 1.5 metres or thereby southeast of the extended southeast kerbline of Orchard Street southeastwards for a distance of 36 metres of thereby.-
3. That length of footpath, shown zebra hatched on the plan annexed, from the heel of the footway on the south side of Brandon Street southwards then westwards then southwestwards for a distance of 95 metres or thereby to the heel of the footway on the north side of Station Road.

Proposed Prohibition of Driving Order

THE STRATHCLYDE REGIONAL COUNCIL propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order imposing prohibition of driving restrictions at four gaps in the central reservation of the A739, Switchback Road, between its junctions with Ballater Drive and Henderland Road, Bearsden. It is also proposed to introduce prohibition of driving restrictions, except emergency vehicles, at the junctions of the A739, Switchback Road with Henderland Road, Warlaw Road and Switchbank Road (Service Road), and a prohibition of driving restriction, except emergency service vehicles and cyclists, in Switchback Road (Service Road) to the south of its junction with Cairnhill Road, Bearsden.
