

## COMPANY DIRECTORS DISQUALIFICATION ACT 1986

IN a Summary Application presented to the Sheriff Court at Paisley in terms of section 6 of the above Act at the instance of Her Majesty's Secretary of State for Trade and Industry in respect of Francis William Paul Campbell, 3 Links Crescent, Barassie, Troon, the Court has, on 31st October 1994 ordered, *inter alia*, the following:-

"The Sheriff on Pursuer's Motion in absence grants an Order for disqualification under section 6(1) of the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 against Francis William Paul Campbell, residing at 3 Links Crescent, Barassie, Troon ordering that he shall not without leave of the Court, be a director of a company or, in any way directly or indirectly, be concerned or to take part in the promotion, formation or management of a company for a period of eight years commencing as at today's date; Directs that the making of the said Order be registered by the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry; Appoints intimation of the Order to be made once in *The Edinburgh Gazette*; finds the Respondent liable to the Applicant in the expenses as taxed; Allows an account thereof to be given in and remits same when lodged to the Auditor of Court to tax and to report."
