

1. The general effect of the Order will be to make it unlawful to drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along that length of road detailed in the Schedule hereto. The Order shall commence on 18th November 1994.
2. The Order (as made) and relevant plan (S/T/10D/8) may be inspected at the Council Offices, English Street, Dumfries and at New Galloway Post Office, High Street, New Galloway during normal office hours between 17th November 1994 and 26th December 1994.
3. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 14th November 1994 apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
