12365/0004	Laboratoires Ethypharm	Ethypharm Doxycycline Capsules 100 mg	Doxycycline Hyclate EP 115.40 mg (Equivalent to Doxycycline Base) 100.00 mg	<p>Infected traumatic and postoperative wounds, furunculosis, impetigo, cellulitis, abscess and paronychia, caused by susceptible stains of the Klebsiella-enterobacter group, as well as susceptible strains of staphylococcus aureus, streptococcus species, E coli and staphylococcus albus, doxycycline treatment of soft tissue infections should always be carried out in conjunction with any necessary indicated surgical procedures.</p> <p><b>Dermatological Infections:</b> Acne vulgaris and acne conglobata.</p> <p>As Doxycycline is one of the tetracycline group of antibiotics, it may be expected to be useful in the treatment of infections which respond to other tetracyclines such as:</p> <p><b>Gastro-intestinal infections:</b> Caused by susceptible strains of such organisms as shigella species, salmonella species, entamoeba histolytica and enteropathogenic E. Coli.</p> <p><b>Ophthalmic Infections:</b> Caused by susceptible strains of staphylococci, gonococci and haemophilus influenzae. Doxycycline is indicated for the treatment of inclusion conjunctivitis either alone or in combination with topical agents. Doxycycline is also suitable in the treatment of trachoma. However, with infectious agent is not eliminated on all occasions, as tested by immunofluorescence techniques.</p> <p><b>Miscellaneous:</b> Trigonitis and prostatitis caused by proteus species. Psittacosis, certain other infections caused by susceptible strains of bacteroides species, listeria species, rickettsia species, yersinia species, brucella species (in combination with streptomycin) and bordetella pertussis, calymmato-bacterium granulomatis, spirochaetes (treponema species), bacillus anthracis, neisseria meningitis and clostridium welchii. Doxycycline may be useful adjunct to amoebicides in the treatment of acute intestinal amoebiasis.</p>	11th August 1994
