Cefaclor is active against the following organisms in vitro: alpha- and beta- haemolytic streptococci, staphylococci including coagulase-positive, coagulase-negative and penicillinase-producing strains, streptococcus pneumoniae, streptococcus pyogenes (group a beta-haemolytic streptococci), branhamella catarrhalis, escherichia coli. Proteus mirabilis, Klebsiella species, haemophilus influenzae, including ampicillin resistant strains. Cefaclor has no activity against pseudomonas species or acinetobacter species. Methicillin resistant staphylococci and most strains of enterococci (eg. Str. Faecalis) are resistant to cefaclor. Cefaclor is not active against most strains of enterobacter SPP, serratia SPP, Morganella morganii, proteus vulgaris and providencia rettgeri. Cefaclor is generally effective in the eradication of streptococci from the nasopharynx. However, data established efficiency in the subsequent prevention of either rheumatic fever or bacterial endocarditis are not available.</p>	11th January 1995
