- A. The importation of CB apparatus is restricted by the Wireless Telegraphy (Citizens' Band and Amateur Apparatus) (Various Provisions) Order 1988 (S.I.1988/

1215) ("the Order").

- B. The Secretary of State is satisfied that this Authority and the terms and conditions attached to it are compatible with the international obligations of the United Kingdom.

Now, therefore:

1. The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7 of the 1967 Act, gives authority to any person to import CB apparatus from another Member State of the European Community or the European Economic Area, the importation of which would be prohibited by the Order.

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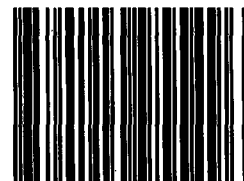
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
