ANIMAL HEALTH ACT 1981

THE IMPORTATION OF ANIMALS ORDER 1977 (ARTICLE 3(2))

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR SCOTLAND, by this licence issued under Article 3(2) of the Importation of Animals Order 1977, hereby authorises the landing in Scotland, in accordance with the conditions set out below, of cattle over 15 days of age originating in Northern Ireland at any port/airport in Scotland.

Scotland General Licence No. 93/4 dated 13th May 1993 is hereby revoked.

This licence is valid until varied or revoked by the Secretary of State.

Conditions:

All landings of cattle shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Importation of Animals Order 1977 and with the following provisions of this licence.

1. Each consignment of cattle shall be accompanied by a certificate signed by an authorised veterinary inspector of the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland giving the description, ear number, sex and age of the cattle to which it relates stating that:

- 1.1 the cattle originate from herds which are Officially Brucellosis Free; Officially Tuberculosis Free and Leukosis Free in accordance with Council Directive 64/432/EEC (as amended);
- 1.2 during the 30 days immediately prior to export all cattle except those for immediate slaughter have passed a comparative intradermal tuberculin test carried out in accordance with the provisions of Annex B of Directive 64/432/EEC;
- 1.3 during the 30 days immediately prior to export all cattle, other than steers and cattle for immediate slaughter were subjected to the serum agglutination test for brucellosis (*B.abortus* antigen) with negative results (negative is a titre of less than 30 iu/ml);
- 1.4 the cattle were examined by the certifying veterinarian at the time of shipment to Great Britain and showed no evidence of infectious or contagious disease, including warble fly, and were fit to travel.
- 1.5 conditions of 1.2 above do not apply to cattle under 42 days of age;
- 1.6 conditions of 1.3 above do not apply to cattle under 12 months of age.
2. After consignment from their premises of origin the cattle must be kept separate from animals not similarly certified.
3. The importer shall give 24 hours advance notification of expected time of arrival to the local DVO.
4. Shipment must be direct from Northern Ireland to Scotland.
5. The cattle, having landed at the port/airport, shall immediately be taken to their final destination.
6. The appropriate health certification should accompany the consignment to its final destination and be retained for a minimum period of 12 months for presentation to an inspector on request.

Note:

In the event of the consignment being delayed or postponed please advise the Animal Health Office responsible for the destination.

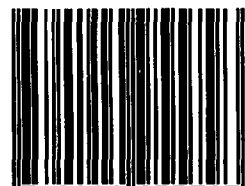
