A93 NORTH DEESIDE ROAD, KINCARDINE O'NEIL

THE GRAMPIAN REGIONAL COUNCIL propose to make "The Grampian Regional Council (A93 North Deeside Road, Kincardine O'Neil) (Restricted Road) Order 1995", under Sections 81(1), 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from being driven at a speed exceeding 30 mph on that length of the A93 North Deeside Road, Kincardine O'Neil, from a point 440 metres or thereby east of Neil Burn Drive to a point 660 metres or thereby west of Neil Burn Drive.

Full details of the proposals are contained in a draft order, which together with a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the order, may be examined during normal office hours in the Roads Department, Woodhill House, Westburn Road, Aberdeen, at the offices of the Divisional Road Surveyor, Carlton House, Arduathie Road, Stonehaven, and in the Banchory Area Office, Silverbank Roads Department, Station Road, Banchory.
