Section over which 30 mph speed limit will be applicable

Clackmannan - B.910 From a point 212 metres or thereby north of Burnside Crescent in a south westerly direction to a point 185 metres or thereby west of Mary Place. (4)

(f) From its junction with Watson Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.

(g) From its junction with Watson Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 7 metres or thereby.

2. On the south side thereof:-

(a) From its junction with Grahams Road in a westerly direction to the projected east kerblines of the most easterly entrance/exit to/from Meeks Road Car Park.

(b) From the projected west kerblines of the most easterly entrance/exit to/from Meeks Road Car Park in a westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.

(c) From the projected east kerblines of the most westerly entrance/exit to/from Meeks Road Car Park in an easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.

(d) From the projected west kerblines of the most westerly entrance/exit to/from Meeks Road Car Park in a westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.

(e) From the projected east kerblines of Hope Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres or thereby.

(f) From the west kerblines of Hope Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 5 metres or thereby.

THE CENTRAL REGION (VARIOUS STREETS, FALKIRK) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 1995

THE CENTRAL REGIONAL COUNCIL propose to make an Order under Sections 1(1) & (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will control parking and improve the free flow of traffic in the streets surrounding Meeks Road Car Park.

Full details of this proposal are in the draft Order which, together with a copy of the relative plan and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for promoting the Order, may be examined at the Regional Council's Offices, Viewforth, Stirling (Room 19), C.H.I.S.P. Office, 23/25 High Street, Falkirk and at Falkirk District Council's Offices, Municipal Buildings, Falkirk during normal office hours free of charge for three weeks from 3rd August 1995.

1. On the east side thereof from the projected south kerblines of Meeks Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 8 metres or thereby.
2. On the west side thereof from the projected south kerblines of Meeks Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 9 metres or thereby.

Hope Street

1. On the east side thereof from the projected south kerblines of Meeks Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 15 metres or thereby.
2. On the west side thereof from the projected south kerblines of Meeks Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 15 metres or thereby.

Grahams Road

1. On the west side thereof:-
 - (a) From the projected south kerblines of Meeks Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 18 metres or thereby.

1. On the north side thereof:-
 - (a) From its junction with Grahams Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 44 metres or thereby.
 - (b) From its junction with Russel Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.
 - (c) From its junction with Russel Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.
 - (d) From its junction with Alma Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.
 - (e) From its junction with Alma Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.
