COMPANY DIRECTORS DISQUALIFICATION ACT 1986

IN a Petition presented to the Court of Session in terms of section 6(1) to the above Act at the instance of Her Majesty's Secretary of State for Trade and Industry in respect of Frederick George Paterson of 10 Kilburn Water, Largs, Lord Osborne has on 8th August 1995 pronounced, *inter alia*, the following:-

"The Lord Ordinary having considered the Petition and proceedings, no answers having been lodged, disqualifies the respondent Frederick George Paterson, without leave of a court from being a director of a company or whether directly or indirectly being concerned or taking part in the promotion, formation or management of a company for a period of 10 years from this date; directs the making of this Order to be registered by the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry and appoints intimation hereof to be made once by advertisement in *The Edinburgh Gazette*; finds said respondent liable to the petitioner in the expenses of the petition and submits the account thereof, when lodged, to the auditor of court for taxation."
