RRO/1995(158) George Street, Dunblane

On the west side of that section of road from a point 30m or thereby north of the junction with Hillside Avenue in a northerly direction for a distance of 3.5 m or thereby (end on).

On the north side of that section of road from a point 10m or thereby east of the junction with Burns Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 6.6 m or thereby.
