THE MONKLANDS DISTRICT COUNCIL hereby give notice that they have made an Order under section 199 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972 authorising the stopping up of the unnamed footpath extending to 32 metres and 5 decimal or one tenth parts of a metre or thereby in length from its junction with the west footway on Sherdale Avenue, Chapelhall, to a point level with the west by south westmost boundary bounding the subjects forming Numbers 64 and 66 Sherdale Avenue, Chapelhall.
