THE SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCIL A970 SANDWICK PHASE I (STOPPING UP) ORDER 1996

NOTICE is hereby given that the Shetland Islands Council propose to make an Order under Section 68(1) (b) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 stopping up the road described in the Schedule hereto.
