HAZELEY DOWN MINERAL WATER COMPANY LTD

WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL has considered an application from Hazeley Down Mineral Water Company Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Southern Water plc for the council to recognise a Mineral Water Source under the above Regulations.

The Natural Mineral Water Regulations 1985 permit the Council to recognise a water source if the water satisfies certain criteria listed in Schedule 1 of the Regulations. The criteria include the physical and chemical characteristics of the water, microbiological analysis, toxic substances, freedom from pollution and stability.

All the criteria have been satisfied and analysis has confirmed that the water was chemically and physically suitable for human consumption.

Take notice therefore that on the 16th January 1996, Winchester City Council recognised the designation of Hazeley Down Mineral Water obtained at Borehole No. 3 at Twyford Pumping Station, Twyford, near Winchester in Hampshire as natural mineral water for the purposes of the Natural Mineral Water Regulations 1985.
