NOTICE is hereby given that PowerGen plc has applied under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 for the consent of the Secretary of State for Scotland to construct and operate a combined cycle gas turbine power station at Gartcosh in the District of Strathkelvin, Strathclyde, and for a direction under Schedule 8 paragraph 7 of the Act that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.

The CCGT power station would be fuelled by natural gas and would be developed in two phases, each of approximately 350MWe (megawatts of electrical energy). Each place would comprise a gas turbine, a heat recovery steam generator, a steam turbine, an electric generator and a stack. Mechanical draught wet cooling towers (of a hybrid type to minimise plume emissions) are proposed as the means of cooling. Water for the cooling system would be taken from the Monklands Canal. Some auxiliary plant would also be necessary. A decision on development of the second phase will be taken in the light of future market conditions.
