##### THE ORKNEY ISLANDS COUNCIL (RESTRICTED ROADS) (ORPHIR) ORDER 1996

THE ORKNEY ISLANDS COUNCIL proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to impose a speed limit of thirty miles per hour on the following public roads:- A964 at Orphir from a point 25 metres or thereby westsouthwest of the access road adjacent to Frehnleiten, Orphir, to a point at the northeastmost corner of Souley Cottage, Orphir, a distance of approximately 690 metres; and C15 Gyre Road, Orphir, from its junction with the A964 at Orphir Church to a point 50 metres or thereby south of the access to Nirvana, Orphir, a distance of approximately 239 metres.

Details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a copy of the relative plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected during normal office hours at the Chief Executive's Department, Council Offices, Kirkwall, Orkney.
