THE A76 TRUNK ROAD (CLOSEBURN) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 199

THE A78 TRUNK ROAD (SALTCOATS) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 199

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 THE ROSSIE MOOR NATURE CONSERVATION ORDER 1996

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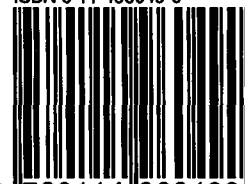
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
