THE A78 TRUNK ROAD (SALTCOATS) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 199

THE SECRETARY OF STATE gives notice that he proposes to make the above Order imposing a 30mph speed limit on that length of the A78 Trunk Road in Saltcoats from a point 15 metres or thereby east of its junction with Sorbie Road, Ardrossan to a point 43 metres or thereby west of the extended west kerbline of Graham Avenue, Stevenston, a distance of 1,848 metres or thereby. It is proposed that the current 40mph speed limit should be reduced in conjunction with other traffic calming measures being introduced in Saltcoats.

THE IMPORTATION OF ANIMALS ORDER 1977

Scotland General Licences Nos 93/3, 93/5 and 94/1 dated 13th May 1993, 13th May 1993 and 21st March 1994 respectively are hereby revoked. This licence is valid until varied or revoked by the Secretary of State.

CONDITIONS

1. All landings of sheep/goats shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Importation of Animals Order 1977 and with the following provisions of this licence.
2. Shipment must be direct from Northern Ireland to Scotland.
3. All animals are to be identified with an eartag bearing an individual identification number.
4. The sheep/goats shall be accompanied by the following document:

A certificate signed by a veterinary inspector appointed by the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland stating that:

- 4.1 The sheep/goats were examined by him immediately before consignment to Great Britain and
 - 4.1.1 showed no evidence of infectious or contagious disease and were fit to travel.
 - 4.1.2 after examination they have been kept separate from sheep/goats not so certified.
 - 4.1.3 are not animals which are to be destroyed under a national contagious or infectious disease eradication programme.
 - 4.1.4 the animals do not originate from premises under restriction on animal health grounds.
 - 4.1.5 the veterinary inspector has received a declaration signed by the exporter stating that the animals have been resident in Northern Ireland for at least 30 days prior to export.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

1. Importers, must ensure that the Animal Health Office responsible for the place of destination is notified of the proposed import at least 24 hours before the expected time of arrival.
2. Arrival at the destination, shall be notified to the Animal Health Office responsible.
3. The health certification must accompany the consignment to its final destination and be retained there for a minimum

period of 12 months for presentation to an inspector on request.

NOTE

In the event of the consignment being delayed or postponed importers should advise the Animal Health Office responsible for the place of destination.

S.I. 1996 No. 2264

This Order may be cited as the Heads of Sheep & Goats Order 1996 and shall come into force on 15th September 1996.

This Order prohibits the sale for human consumption of any part of the head of a sheep or goat and of food containing any part of such heads. It also prohibits the sale of any part of the head of a sheep or goat for use in the preparation of food for sale for human consumption and the use of any part of such heads in the preparation of such food (article 3). The definition of "the head of a sheep or goat" does not include the tongue and the prohibitions do not apply to the heads of sheep and goats which were born, reared and slaughtered in Australia or New Zealand.

2. The proposed modifications would introduce into these licences a condition entitled *Maintenance of effective competition where the Licensee has an international connection authorisation in a designated country* and supporting disclosure requirements.

3. The effect of the proposed modification is to empower the Director to require remedial action to be taken, where the Licensee is authorised in the UK by his licence to provide International Simple Resale ("ISR") Services and also operates a telecommunications system in another country which is authorised to be connected to one in the UK, and the Licensee is acting, or failing to act, in such a way as to restrict, distort or prevent competition in the United Kingdom.
4. This standard condition was not included in ISR licences until some time after ISR was first permitted in the UK. The above mentioned licences are among those which do not currently contain such a condition. It is important that where such Licences are also seeking international facilities licences, they should be subject to an equal regulatory regime. The Director therefore proposes to make the modification described above in order to put these Licensees on the same footing as other licences in this respect.
5. The Director is required by section 12(2) of the Act to consider any representations or objections which are duly made and not withdrawn. Following such consideration and the consent of the Licensees to the modifications, the Director proposes to make the modifications forthwith.
