### THE A96 TRUNK ROAD (KINTORE) (VARIABLE SPEED LIMIT) (NO 2) ORDER 199

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the above Order imposing a 20 mph speed limit on that length of School Road, Kintore from a point 12 metres or thereby north of the centreline of Nicol Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 335 metres or thereby.
