PROTOCOL TO DOUBLE TAXATION CONVENTION WITH DENMARK

THE PROTOCOL to the 1980 Double Taxation Convention between the United Kingdom and Denmark which was signed in London on 15th October 1996, entered into force on 20th June 1997. The text has been published as the Schedule to the Double Taxation Relief (Taxes on Income) (Denmark) Order 1996 (Statutory Instrument 1996 No. 3165).

PROTOCOL TO DOUBLE TAXATION CONVENTION WITH FINLAND

THE PROTOCOL to the 1970 UK/Finland Double Taxation Convention which was signed in Helsinki on 31st July 1996 entered into force on 8th August 1997. The text has been published as the Schedule to the Double Taxation Relief (Taxes on Income) (Finland) Order 1996 (Statutory Instrument 1996 No. 3166).

PARLIAMENTARY APPROVAL AND EFFECTIVE DATES

Both Orders were approved by Parliament on 12th November 1996 and details of the debate can be found in the House of Commons Official Report, Second Standing Committee on Delegated Legislation, of the same date. Copies of the Orders and Official Report are available from the Stationery Office.

The provisions of both protocols will take effect in the United Kingdom from 1st April 1998 for corporation tax and from 6th April 1998 for income tax and capital gains tax; the provisions of the appropriate protocol will apply in Denmark and Finland from 1st January 1998.

10.	Notices outwith the above categories will be charged at a line rate of £35.60 (£30.30 + VAT) for up to 10 lines of printed matter and an additional £14.10 (£12 + VAT) for each 5 lines or part of 5 lines.		

The charges under 1-4 are in respect of notices covering one company only. If notices include more than one company, in the same group of companies they will be charged as follows:-

2 to 5 companies . . . double the single company rate
6 to 10 companies . . . treble the single company rate

Pre-payment is required for these rates. In the case of notices under 10 above pre-payment of £35.60 (£30.30 + VAT) is required. You will be invoiced for any balance.

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
