 (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1997

ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL has made "The Aberdeen City Council (On-Street Parking Places) Order, 1997", under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is as stated in *The Press and Journal* and also *The Edinburgh Gazette* of 5th August 1997; namely, to restate all the existing on-street 'pay and display' arrangements currently in force in Aberdeen, but to vary charging and time-limitation requirements (as stated below). The Order comes into operation on Monday, 6th October 1997.

The new charge for the streets named in the first schedule hereto (instead of 70p up to one hour and £1.40 for one to two hours - two hours maximum stay) is £1.00p for a maximum stay of one hour.

The new charges for the streets named in the second schedule hereto (instead of 70p up to one hour and £1.40p for one to two hours - two hours maximum stay) are 80p up to one hour and £1.60p for one to two hours (two hours maximum stay).

The new charges for the streets named in the third schedule hereto (instead of 40p for two hours and 70p for two to three hours - three hours maximum stay) are 50p for two hours and 80p for two to three hours (three hours maximum stay).

If a street appears in more than one schedule, this means that different "pay and display" arrangements will prevail in different parts of that street.

The cost of an excess charge will remain at £20.00 as before. Residents' exemption permits will continue to be available; the annual cost of these is still £20.00. Members of the public should note that, as before, a permit can only be used in relation to "pay and display" parking bays (not yellow lines) and only in the zone for which it was issued. Also, it will continue to be the case that only one permit per household will be permitted in central zones whereas a maximum of two per household will apply in peripheral zones. For information about these points, please telephone the number given below.

Contractors' daily tickets will also continue to be available at a cost of £5.00 per day for service engineers, builders, and other tradesmen engaged upon building works (or similar) at an address adjacent to "pay and display" bays in any length of road specified in the first and second schedules. This ticket will suspend the charging requirement, in respect of the contractor's vehicle, for the day in question.

ABERDEEN CITY COUNCIL has made "The Aberdeen City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1997", under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is as stated in *The Press and Journal* and also *The Edinburgh Gazette* of 5th August 1997; namely, to restate all existing off-street "pay and display" arrangements currently in force in Aberdeen, but vary charging requirements. The Order comes into effect on Monday, 6th October 1997.

The new Order therefore restates all the general management regulations applying to the car parks managed by Aberdeen City Council (e.g. prohibitions of trading, camping etc.), but this represents no change in the current circumstances.

All the new charges are summarised in the schedule below.

The cost of an excess charge will remain at £20.00 as before; monthly season tickets (for long-stay car parks only) will continue to be available in exactly the same way but at the higher price of £80.00.
