NOTICE OF PROPOSED ALTERATION TO FIFE STRUCTURE PLAN**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997 ("the Act")**

NOTICE is hereby given that The Fife Council ("the Council") proposes to alter the Fife Structure Plan. Further to this, the Council requires to undertake consultations regarding its proposed alteration in terms of Section 9(4) of the Act before submitting its proposed attention to the Secretary of State for approval.

The Council therefore gives notice that its proposed alteration is Draft Alteration No. 1 - Housing. This alteration primarily relates to Chapter 5 of the Consolidated Structure Plan (July 1994).

In The Edinburgh Gazette published on 31st October a notice appeared in respect of the following Order. Unfortunately in the original notice the date referred to as the closing date for objections was incorrect, and the notice also failed to state that the purpose of the Order was to permit the shared use of footways by both cyclists and pedestrians. In the circumstances the Council has decided to re-advertise the Order. The details of the roads listed in the Schedule to the Order are the same as before.

THE ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984**THE FIFE COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, GLENROTHES AND LESLIE) (REDETERMINATION OF MEANS OF EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF PASSAGE) ORDER 1997**

NOTICE is hereby given that The Fife Council propose to make an Order under section 152(2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 redetermining the means of exercise of the public right of passage over the roads described in the Schedule hereto.

The title of the Order is "The Fife Council (Various Roads, Glenrothes and Leslie) (Redetermination of Means of Exercise of Public Right of Passage) Order 1997".

A copy of the proposed Order and of the accompanying plans showing the roads over which the means of exercise of the public right of passage is to be redetermined, together with a Statement of the Reasons for making the Order have been deposited at the offices of The Fife Council, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes, Fife and are available for inspection free of charge during normal office hours until 11th November 1997.

Any person may, within twenty-eight days from the 13th day of November 1997 object to the making of the Order by notice in writing to the undersigned. Objections should state the name and address of the objector, the matters to which they relate and the grounds on which they are made.

SCHEDULE

The purpose of the Order is to redetermine the means of exercise of the public right of passage to permit the shared use of footways by both cyclists and pedestrians in respect of the following roads in Glenrothes and Leslie:-

RIMBLETON AREA, GLENROTHES

That section of footway beginning on the south kerbline of Napier Road from a point 61 metres or thereby west of the west kerbline of Napier Place in a southerly direction for a distance of 123 metres or thereby.

That section of footway from the northeast corner kerb of Munro Place in an easterly direction for a distance of 32 metres or thereby.

That section of footway, from the east kerbline of Swan Place in an easterly direction for a distance of 39 metres or thereby then in a southerly direction for a distance of 64 metres or thereby.

That section of footway beginning on the north kerbline of South Parks Road from a point 40 metres or thereby east of the east kerbline of Scott Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 177 metres or thereby.

That section of footway beginning on the east kerbline of Scott Road from a point 107 metres or thereby north of the north kerbline of South Parks Road in an easterly direction to the west kerbline of Raeburn Path, a distance of 97 metres or thereby.
