- (3) introduce a weight restriction of 7.5 tonnes maximum gross laden weight on Walker Avenue and Institution Terrace and
- (4) stop up the south end of Old Castlegate.

The existing one-way restriction on Old Castlegate from its junction with Castle Street/High Street to its junction with Castle Lane (northwards) will be revoked but the existing prohibition of driving on Old Castlegate except for access will be retained. This means that driving on Old Castlegate will be prohibited except for taking access to properties and access will only be from Castle Lane.

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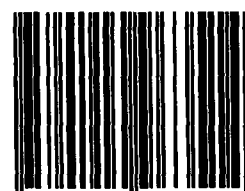
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
