THE A82 TRUNK ROAD (LONGMAN ROAD, INVERNESS) (30MPH AND 40MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 199

THE SECRETARY OF STATE give notice that he proposes to make the above Order which will alter the existing 30mph and 40mph speed limits on the A82 trunk road at Longman Road, Inverness as follows:-
