#### THE A82 TRUNK ROAD (LONGMAN ROAD, INVERNESS) (30MPH AND 40MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 199

THE SECRETARY OF STATE give notice that he proposes to make the above Order which will alter the existing 30mph and 40mph speed limits on the A82 trunk road at Longman Road, Inverness as follows:-

- 1. The 30mph speed limit will be extended from the junction with Harbour Road northeastwards for a distance of 108 metres or thereby.
- 2. The 40mph speed limit will be repositioned such that it will be from a point 108 metres or thereby northeast of the junction with Harbour Road northeastwards to a point 102 metres southwest of the junction with the A9, a distance of 483 metres or thereby.
