**NOTICE OF VARIATION OF PRIVATE MOBILE RADIO
(STANDARD) LICENCE**

THE SECRETARY OF STATE hereby gives notice, pursuant to section 1(4) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949, to holders of the Private Mobile Radio (Standard) Licence that, with effect from 31st July 1998, each Licence shall be varied as follows:

1. Existing on-site services shall be transferred from Private Mobile Radio (Standard) licences to On-site Private Business Radio licences.
2. Following the transfer of on-site services, Private Mobile Radio (Standard) licences without any remaining services shall be revoked.

Representations with respect to the above proposals, which were outlined in detail in the spectrum pricing special edition of Private Business Radio News, may be made to the Radiocommunications Agency within 28 days of this notice. The spectrum pricing special edition of Private Business Radio News was sent to all Private Business Radio licensees in June 1998 and is available from the Agency's Enquiry Point on 0171 211 0211.

The proposals do not apply to on-site services in the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man. These on-site services will continue to be licensed by Private Mobile Radio (Standard) licences until further notice.

An 'on-site' service is a radio system with a limited operating area normally up to 3 km in radius from a specified location.

The Director General of Electricity Supply (hereinafter referred to as "the Director") pursuant to section 11(2) of the Electricity Act 1989 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") hereby gives notice as follows:
