Notice under Section 11(2) of The Electricity Act 1989

The Director General of Electricity Supply ("the Director") hereby gives notice pursuant to section 11(2) of the Electricity Act 1989 ("the Act") as follows:

1. The Director proposes to modify the conditions of the licences granted under section 6(1)(a) of the Act and held by National Power plc, PowerGen plc, Magnox Electric plc, Scottish Nuclear Ltd, Nuclear Electric Ltd and First Hydro Ltd (the "Generators").
2. He proposes to modify the conditions of these licences because an obligation not to discriminate unduly between customers, in the supply of electricity to customers in a market within which the supplier is dominant, has been included in the licences granted to suppliers under section 6(2) of the Act.
3. In summary, the Director proposes to modify the conditions of these licences granted under section 6(1)(a) of the Act by replacing the condition prohibiting discrimination on all sales of electricity with a new condition which prohibits each Generator from unduly discriminating in the sale of electricity to purchasers other than to final customers requiring a supply of electricity.

The Director General of Electricity Supply ("the Director") hereby gives notice pursuant to section 11(2) of the Electricity Act 1989 ("the Act") as follows:

- A The Director proposes to modify the conditions of the licences granted under section 6(1)(a), 6(1)(b) and 6(1)(c) of the Act and held by Scottish Hydro-Electric plc and Scottish Power plc (the "Public Electricity Suppliers").

He proposes to modify the conditions of these licences to ensure the establishment of suitable trading arrangements in order to facilitate competition in electricity supply within Scotland.

In summary, the Director proposes to modify the conditions of these licences granted under sections 6(1)(a), 6(1)(b) and 6(1)(c) of the Act by introducing a new condition and new definitions which shall require the Public Electricity Suppliers together:

- 1) to procure that there is established, operated and maintained a system ("the settlement system") to facilitate the proper functioning of trading arrangements in Scotland, and to provide for matters ancillary to those arrangements which are or may be appropriate to facilitate competition in electricity supply within Scotland;
- 2) to procure the preparation of a form of agreement ("the settlement agreement") under which the settlement system shall be made available to third parties, and which shall also include terms (to be approved by the Director) allowing for its own variation and for the payment of reasonable charges for provision of the settlement system; and
- 3) to procure that an offer to enter into the settlement agreement is made to any person who is an appropriate user of the settlement system.

- B. The Director proposes to modify the conditions of the licences granted under section 6(2) of the Act and held by Scottish Power plc, East Midlands Electricity plc, Midlands Electricity plc, Scottish Hydro-Electric plc, Impkemix Energy Ltd, Seeboard plc, South Wales Electricity plc, PowerGen plc, Yorkshire Electricity Croup plc, Northern Electric plc, Southern Electric plc, Eastern Electricity plc, South Western Electricity plc, Energy Supply Contracts Ltd, Magnox Electric plc, Manweb plc, London Electricity plc, Norweb plc, BG plc, Enron Gas & Petrochemical Trading Ltd, Nuclear Electric Ltd, British Gas Trading Ltd, Independent Energy UK Ltd, Electricity Direct (UK) Ltd, Enron Direct Ltd, Eastern Energy Ltd and National Power plc (the "Private Electricity Suppliers").
