THE A701 TRUNK ROAD (LOCHARBRIGGS) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 199

COMPANY DIRECTORS DISQUALIFICATION ACT 1986

"The Sheriff, Having Heard Parties Procurators; Grants a Disqualification Order under Section 6(1) of the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 against William Alexander McDonald, Milton of Conon, Carmyllie, Arbroath ordering that he shall not, without leave of the Court, be a Director of a company or be a liquidator or administrator of a company, or be a receiver or manager of a company's property or in any way whether directly or indirectly be concerned to take part in the promotion, formation or management of a company for a period of 2 years beginning with the date hereof, Directs that the making of said Order be registered by the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry; Appoints intimation of the Order to be made once in *The Edinburgh Gazette* and *The Dundee Courier and Advertiser*; Finds the Defender liable to the Pursuer in the expenses of the application as taxed by the Auditor of Court."
