SOUTH LANARKSHIRE COUNCIL propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order (On-Street Parking and Charges).

The purpose of this Order will be to provide short-term on-street parking places. This order proposed to introduce charges for parking on parts of Glebe Street, Glebe Crescent, Kirkton Park, Kittoch Street, Main Street, Maxwell Drive, and Stuart Street, East Kilbride.
