THE WEST LOTHIAN COUNCIL (A71/BREICH, A89 BLACKRIDGE, A706 LONGRIDGE AND B7066 GREENRIGG) (RESTRICTED ROADS) ORDER 199-TO/98/23

The West Lothian Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, propose to make an Order the effect of which would be to extend the existing lengths of restricted road in Blackridge, Longridge and Greenrigg and designate the A71 through Breich as restricted road to bring it into line with other villages in the area. This will facilitate the erection of village gateways. The lengths of roads affected are specified in the Schedule below.

A copy of the draft Order together with (1) a map showing the roads affected and (2) a Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Order and (3) a copy of the 1985 Order may be examined during the period 14th January to 12th February 1999 between the hours of 9 am and 4.30 pm Mondays to Fridays at: West Lothian House, Almondvale Boulevard, Livingston and West Calder Area Housing Office, 1 East End, West Calder and during normal opening hours at Armadale Library, West Main Street, Armadale.

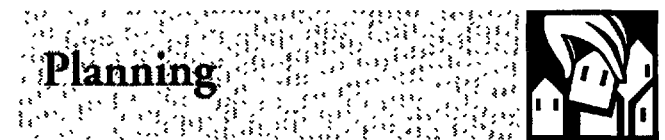
